



Curriculum Consultation (July 2019)

St Mary's curriculum has been co-designed by pupils, staff, parents and Governors. Feedback was obtained about which skills and knowledge SMPS pupils should have when they leave our school and the findings formed an integral part of our curriculum design.

Pupils wanted to leave St Mary's with:

- More experience of outdoor learning
- A greater understanding of politics
- Baking skills
- More experience of practical activities across the curriculum

Staff wanted to see pupils leave St Mary's with:

- A resurrection mindset that promotes growth, resilience and perseverance
- An opportunity to shine and be proud of their achievements
- A global perspective, so that they can be global citizens of God
- Knowledge rich, with transferrable skills across the curriculum and in life

Parents / Carers wanted to see pupils leave St Mary's with:

- Global awareness
- Access to key skills for their future
- A broad understanding of key events in history
- An understanding of local history
- Creativity
- Exposure to different languages
- Access to learning a musical instrument
- Cooking and healthy eating skills.

Governors wanted to see pupils leave St Mary's with:

- Children to be secondary ready and leave St Mary's with the knowledge and skills they need to thrive in secondary school and beyond
- For all children to have the cultural capital they need for future success in education and beyond, regardless of their starting points
