Behaviour Policy – November 2019
Addendum to the Behaviour Policy during COVID-19 – May 2020

“Love the Lord your God, with all your heart, soul and mind.”
“Love your neighbour as you love yourself.”

Jesus said that these are the most important commands. They form the foundation for outstanding behaviour in all aspects of life at St. Mary’s Primary.

All students should continue to adhere to the principles outlined in the Behaviour Policy. In particular, students should be mindful of the following:

- 1. You should be respectful and kind to all.**
- 2. You should be safe, responsible and courteous at all times.**

Online communication via Dojo

Students should be aware of the following:

- Students’ behaviour and comments should be exemplary, reflecting how they would behave in a lesson.
- Students should address teachers and refer to peers as they would do in a classroom setting.
- If any student behaves inappropriately, parents will be informed and appropriate actions undertaken, in line with the main behaviour policy.
- • Students working in in school during this time should adhere to the school’s Behaviour Policy.
- Any changes allowed in regards to student conduct (for instance, use of mobile phones) will be explained clearly to students, after consultation with appropriate senior staff.

A member of Senior Leadership will always be present on site, where possible and staff are still contactable via Class Dojo.

Whilst pupils are in school and safety measures need to be in place in order to minimise the spread of COVID-19, the following behaviour principles need to be undertaken:

- Adhere to social distancing (2m) outside of the school premises for drop off and pick up. Pupils will not congregate outside of the school gates / perimeter railings before
